

## Rules and Regulations

*To insure a safe and successful parade, parade participants must adhere to the following:*

- 1) No one will be allowed to drive a vehicle in the parade without a valid Georgia Driver's License and must be over the age of 18. No tractor trailers allowed or mobile homes/recreational vehicles.
- 2) All children riding on floats and vehicles must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3) It is requested that all entries be decorated in a holiday theme.
- 4) Participants who act, or use music or language that is deemed offensive by the organizers (Oxford Lions Club and City of Oxford) will be removed from the parade.
- 5) All entries must be lined up and in position as directed by the committee no later than 10:00am. If you wish to be judged, you must be registered and in the line-up by 9:30am.
- 6) One decorated float is allowed per commercial entry, unless granted prior approval by the committee.
- 7) Candy cannot be thrown from floats. Walkers through the parade route can pass candy or favors.
- 8) Drivers of all vehicles will adhere to parade committee instructions at all times and will follow the directions of the parade route, maintaining a distance of 30 feet between vehicles.
- 9) Participants must display parade number issued at registration.
- 10) All animals must be on a leash or rein at all times.
- 11) Rules and Liability Waiver must be signed by responsible representative of group.

**Participants failing to adhere to these rules may be removed from the parade.**

## Rules and Liability Waiver

In consideration of the acceptance of the right to participate, entrants, participants, spectators by execution of the entry form release the City of Oxford and Oxford Lions Club, and their directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, and anyone else connected with the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade from any and all known and unknown damages, injuries, losses, judgments, and/or claims from any causes whatsoever that may be suffered by an entrant to his person or property. Further, each entrant expressly agrees to indemnify all the foregoing entities, firms, persons, and bodies of any and all labeled, occasioned, or resulting from the conduct of entrants or any participants assisting or co-operating with entrant and under the control of entrant.
