The City of Oxford Governing Authority announce this Special Called Meeting for the purpose and consideration of adopting the 2014 Millage at the Rollback rate of 7.571. Based on the Computation of Millage Rate Rollback and percentage increase in Property taxes from Newton County Tax Commissioner the 2014 Millage Rate is 7.850 with a Rollback rate of 7.571.

- 5. *Video Systems We have attached a recommendation from Chief Harvey that City Council approve a purchase order for \$21,073.40 at the August 4 meeting. These replacement video systems are to be mounted in three patrol cars and are in the FY2015 budget at \$22,800. The equipment for the new patrol car is budgeted separately.
