2. **Committee Reports** – The Trees, Parks and Recreation Board, Planning Commission, Downtown Development Authority, and Sustainability Committee will update the Council on their recent activities.
3. ***Discussion of the Rezoning Application for 808 Wesley Street (0.22+/- acres):** The applicant wishes to rezone the property from the current zoning of R-30 (Single-Family Residential) to IC (Institutional Campus). The Council may choose to deny the application, approve the application, or approve the application with conditions. If there is an approval or conditional approval, the City will proceed to consider the first read of the Rezoning Ordinance.
4. ***Discussion of the Rezoning Ordinance No. 2026-004 for the Rezoning of 808 Wesley Street (0.22+/- acres):** PLEASE NOTE – Mr. James Johnson has prepared Oxford College's recommended conditions for this rezoning and they are attached as document 004a.
5. **Review of the Oxford Complete Streets Plan:** Mr. John Boudreau (AtkinsRéalis) will present the plan and lead the discussion on next steps. The City has approximately \$400,000 for the implementation of this plan. If possible, it would be prudent to match our efforts with a grant opportunity perhaps through the Atlanta Regional Commission. The document was distributed to the Council by a link on 9/18 as it is too large to email.
6. **Consideration of Ms. Jan Ballard for the Oxford Trees, Parks, and Recreation Committee:** TPR recommends Ms. Ballard's appointment to fill a current vacancy. Ms. Ballard resides at 6154 Emory Street. Ms. Ballard has attended a few meetings and would like to be a member of the Committee.
