Excellence Is Rewarded

Oxford employees have benefitted from their dedication to the job. While other cities and counties have reduced their payroll costs by furloughs, unpaid vacation days, and layoffs, Oxford has not had to take such drastic action. All Oxford employees received a 2.5% cost of living increase in 2009. Since that time most employees have received merit increases greater than five percent with the average increase being 8.6 percent. In addition, two employees received performance bonuses.
