The meeting was called to order by the Honorable Jerry D. Roseberry, Mayor

The purpose of this meeting was for the first reading of and ordinance to repeal and adopt a revised ordinance respecting: Chapter 40-711 (9) "Home Occupation-Approval" of the City of Oxford Zoning Ordinance.

Mayor Roseberry delivered the second reading as:

An Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Oxford, Section 40-711 (9) "Home Occupation-Approval" of the City of Oxford Zoning Ordinance, To Repeal, Revoke and Supersede all Ordinances in conflict, To Provide for Severability, To Provide for an Effective Date, and for Other Lawful Purposes.

The hearing was open for any comments or discussion.

Hoyt Oliver added this change is to state that the City Manager will have Authority to approve any Home Occupational Application request.

Clark Miller, City Manager, added that City Attorney, David Strickland found other minor changes which are being corrected such as typographical, section numbers within the ordinance out of sequence etc. There was nothing of substance which would cause conflict with the content of the ordinance.
