

OFFICERS ELECTED AND PRIVATE SECTOR REPRESENTATIVES APPOINTED

The Northeast Georgia Regional Commission (NEGRC) Council held its regular monthly meeting at the Athens Holiday Inn on August 15th. At that time, officers were elected for a two-year term. Walton County Commission Chair **Kevin Little** will serve as Chairman, Newton County Private Sector Representative **Frank Turner** as Vice Chairman, and City of Oxford Mayor **Jerry Roseberry** as Secretary.

Chairman Little has served on the Council (formerly Board of Directors) since January 2000. For many years, he has served as a member and Chairman of the Personnel Committee. He is a Walton County native and is in his fourth term as Chairman of the Walton County Board of Commissioners.

Vice Chairman Turner served for almost thirty-six years as City Manager of the City of Covington. He is a long time Chairman of the Audit & Finance Committee, and in 2007, received the Local Government Administrator of the Year Award.
