

OXFORD'S 175th BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

The selection of 175 persons or groups to be honored as "OXFORD HISTORY MAKERS"

In celebration of the City of Oxford's 175th birthday (1839 – 2014) the Oxford City Council will publish a book recognizing 175 persons and/or groups (such as civic clubs, women's clubs, churches, volunteer groups) who have contributed to the life of our community in exceptional ways over the years. Often these have been ordinary citizens, as well as chosen leaders. We are asking Oxford residents (present and former) to submit nominations of persons or groups to be included.

Submit any names you wish, and tell us why they're "Oxford History Makers." The following criteria are offered as <u>suggested</u> attributes nominees might possess to be considered for recognition as an "Oxford History Maker".

- Exemplified leadership on behalf of the community
- Possessed a gift for imparting knowledge to others
- Gave significant care to others in the community
- Gave of their time, efforts, and talents to the life of the community
- Residents of Oxford who have contributed in such a manner that our country, state, county, city, or generations long afterward have benefited.
- Contributed significantly to the improvement and beautification of the City of Oxford

Citizens are invited to submit nominations for "Oxford History Makers" on the form provided (over); make as many nominations as you wish, using additional sheets of paper.

On each page, please furnish <u>your</u> name; the name of person nominated; and a brief (no more than one page) description of why you think this person or group should be considered.

Completed forms should be returned to Oxford City Hall by <u>February 1, 2014</u>. You may also submit nominations online at www.oxfordgeorgia.org.

The committee will be unable to reply to nominations submitted.

Current elected officials of the City of Oxford are not eligible for nomination.
