

Regular Meeting August 3rd 1897

The Intendant being Absent A. H. Stone Intendant Protem Presided.

The Clerk being sick M. J. Peed acted as Clerk Protem.

The Street Committee reported that the street work was going on and they were not having hands. That Stone acting member stated that as Mr Hardison the Chairman of the Committee was confined to his bed with ~~typhoid~~ fever and as he could not consult him he had taken the responsibility to suspend the rule of not working more than 10 hands per day so as to take the advantage of condition of the street after the summer rains set in. He had ordered Cartload of Sewer pipe and had made trade to pay for it by December 1st the amount we had used - Good work will be done this year and to an advantage.

On Motion Grant is to be given for a lease of 99 years for the sum of (\$5000) fifty dollars to Bishop A. E. Haygood of that part of Cole Street & twelve Clark and George Streets, provided that Bishop Haygood buy the property adjacent and build a residence thereon and provided further that if the town wishes to open up the street leased that it can do so by refunding the said sum of fifty dollars without any further cost or order. And that these conditions shall be embodied in all future deeds to whom said property shall be disposed to.

Bishop J. H. Haygood appeared before the Council and asked that the Town lease him that part of Case Street between George and Clarke Streets and George Street between Wesley & W. Kendric Street.

Prof. J. Fort moved that the Intendant and Clerk be authorized to draw up papers granting lease for the term of 99 years subject to abrogation in case the Town need same for other purposes and under these conditions that the request of Bishop Haygood should be granted. (Carried)
